

Phibby Venable is a poet, novelist, songwriter and community action worker in the historical town of Abingdon, Virginia. She is often referred to as "the Appalachian poet", due to her location on a branch of the Holston River wedged between the Appalachian & Blue Ridge mountains. Nominated twice for the Pushcart Prize, her work has appeared in national & international magazines. Her first novel, *Women of the Round Table*, was released in 2010, followed by a book of poetry, *The Wind Is My Wine*. Some of her poems recently appeared in an anthology in India to help promote the rights of women.
